Rotary Foundation Honors William Nitrauer

William E. Nitrauer, retired educator, was honored Thursday by the Rotary Foundation of Rotary International for his long service to the organization.

Nitrauer has been a Rotarian since 1928 and was governor of District 739 in 1967-68. A former supervising principal
